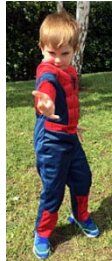
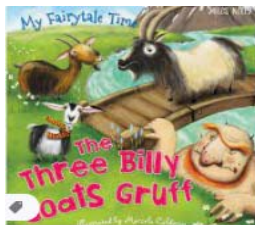
Summer Term 2021

We looked at our school's Mission Statement and thought about ways we could show love to others.



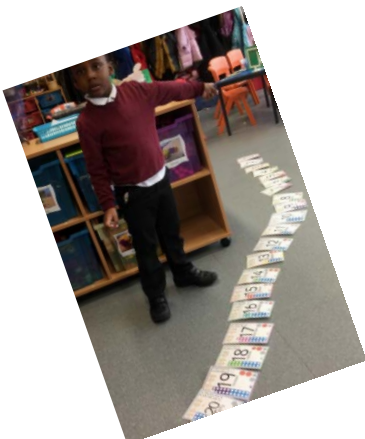
Traditional Tales

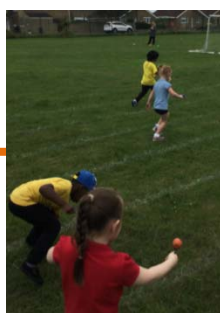
We had some time to climb in the barn and we played on the play park - we had a fabulous time!
